DOG LICENSES

New York State Law requires that every person owning or harboring a dog over the age of 4 months must obtain a dog license. Licenses will be administered by the individual municipalities and they will continue to be enforced locally.

The license is valid for one year and is subject to annual renewal. Renewal reminder notices are sent a month prior to the expiration date.

To obtain a license you will need to have a current rabies vaccination form from a veterinarian that contains the date the shot was given and the expiration date. For dogs that are unable to receive a rabies shot, a Certificate of Exemption from Rabies Vaccination MUST be completed by the attending veterinarian and the dog owner.

If the dog is neutered or spayed a Certificate of Spay or Neutering must also be provided.

Replacement tag - \$3.00
